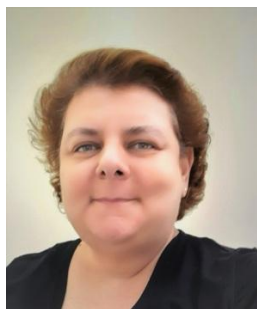


# Maria Vertzoni

Maria Vertzoni is Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Technology and Biopharmaceutics, Department of Pharmacy, National Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA), Greece. She received her Bachelor in Chemistry in 1994, her Master of Science in Analytical Chemistry in 1999 and her Ph.D. in Pharmaceutical Sciences in 2004 from NKUA. Research interests focus to the physicochemical characterization of intraluminal environment and oral drug absorption with special interest in special populations.
