



Andreas Agathangelidis is Assistant Professor of Genetics - Molecular Genetics of Eukaryotic Organisms at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens as well as an Academic Associate at the Institute of Applied Biosciences of the Centre for Research and Technology.

His research interests include cancer genetics, immunobiology of hematologic malignancies and analysis of big biodata. He is a co-author of more than 80 scientific papers, 47 conference presentations and 2 books.
